REVIEW OF ACCOUNTS PAYABLE AND PAYING BILLS END OF FISCAL YEAR

SIDEWALK

Alderman Osborne made a motion, seconded by Alderman Law, to accept the Anderson Concrete and Construction sidewalk bid of \$97,234 plus \$5,000 for dirt work with the school paying half the cost. LAND SURVEY
