
The City of Earlville City Council entered into Closed Session at 8:08 p.m. for the discussion of Litigation, when an action against, affecting or on behalf of the particular public body has been filed and is pending before a court or administrative tribunal, or when the public body finds that an action is probable or imminent, in which case the basis for the finding shall be recorded and entered into the minutes of the closed meeting. Act. (5ILCS 120/2(c)(11)).

The following members were present by voice: Alderman Mark Actis, Alderman Robin Austin, Alderman Chuck Jenkins, City Attorney Mark Anderson, Mayor Mike Hall, City Clerk Jane Bauer, Alderman Walter Grimm, Alderman Michael Konsoer, and Alderman Ken Bonine.

A discussion was held as to whether council members were aware of a meeting between the city and a Federal Mediator.

Legal Counsel, Attorney Anderson, stated there was a memorandum of understanding between the parties and that City Council Member votes indicate the council is in keeping with the mediation.
