


**CITY OF EARLVILLE

The City of Earlville City Council entered into Executive Session at 7:53 p.m. for the purpose of pending or probable litigation against, affecting or on behalf of the public body; (exception to the Open Meetings Act 5ILCS 120/2(c)(11)).

The following members were present: Alderman Mark Actis, Alderman Robin Austin, Alderman Ken Bonine, Alderman Walter Grimm, Alderman Chuck Jenkins, and Alderman Michael Konsoer. Also present were Mayor Mike Hall, City Attorney Mark Anderson, and City Clerk Jane Bauer.

Attorney Anderson addressed the possibility of a litigation if the city holds the low bidder of Stilson Street to the bid. He recommended the city council rescind all bids and re-bid the demolition of the Stilson Street property.
