The City of Earlville City Council entered into Executive Session at 7:40 p.m. for the purpose of discussion of Litigation, when an action against, affecting or on behalf of the particular public body has been filed and is pending before a court or administrative tribunal, or when the public body finds that an action is probable or imminent, in which case the basis for the finding shall be recorded and entered into the minutes of the closed meeting. (exception to the Open Meetings Act 5ILCS 120/2(c)(11))

As verbally acknowledged, the following members were present: Alderman Mark Actis, Alderman Robin Austin, Alderman Chuck Jenkins, Mayor Mike Hall, City Clerk Jane Bauer, Alderman Walter Grimm, Alderman Michael Konsoer, and City Attorney Mark Anderson. Absent: Alderman Ken Bonine.

Attorney Anderson reported on the compliance with agreed order in the EOG agreement. He anticipated having an ordinance for approval for the next meeting to undo what is done.

Attorney Anderson also reported that he had a court order signed by Judge Hettel on the 515 Stilson Street property. The city now has the right to demolish the property but he advised the city to wait 30 days prior to seeking bids to demolish. The city will hold the cost of demolition against the property as a lien, there will be foreclosure on the demolished property, and then the city may engage in purchasing it.

At 7:54 p.m., Alderman Actis made a motion, seconded by Alderman Jenkins, to return to open session. On roll call: Alderman Grimm-aye, Alderman Austin-aye, Alderman Jenkins-aye, Alderman Konsoer-aye, and Alderman Actis-aye. Absent: Alderman Bonine. MOTION CARRIED.
