The City of Earlville City Council entered into Closed Session at 7:17 p.m. to discuss the appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance or dismissal of specific employees of the public body or legal counsel for the public body, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee or legal counsel for the public body to determine its validity. 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(1) and to consider informant sources, the hiring or assignment of undercover personnel or equipment, or ongoing, prior or future criminal investigations, when discussed by a public body with criminal investigatory responsibilities. 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(14)

The following members were present: Alderman Bryan Nelson, Alderman Robin Austin, City Attorney Nigel Smith, Mayor Mark Actis, City Clerk Jane Bauer, Alderman Steven Osborne, Alderman Michael Goodbred, Alderman Edward Farley, Deputy Clerk Martha Dankenbring, Chief Darin Crask, and Alderman Chuck Jenkins by remote participation. Alderman Jenkins immediately exited the closed session meeting.

Chief Darin Crask recommended the employment of two confidential part time officers. Chief Crask was contacted by a colleague with the US Drug Enforcement Agency about working with them. This is an opportunity to work jointly with our federal counterparts and help make Earlville a safer community.
