

**CITY OF EARLVILLE  
CITY COUNCIL  
CLOSED SESSION, SEPTEMBER 12, 2018  
City Hall Council Room, 210 W. Railroad Street, Earlville, IL**

The City of Earlville City Council entered into Closed Session at 7:38 p.m. for the purpose of discussing collective negotiating matters between the public body and its employees or their representatives, or deliberations concerning salary schedules for one or more classes of employees; section 2.06. (5ILCS 120/2(c)(2)).

The following members were present: Alderman Mark Actis, Alderman Robin Austin, Alderman Chuck Jenkins by remote participation, Mayor Mike Hall, City Clerk Jane Bauer, Alderman Walter Grimm, Alderman Michael Konsoer, and Attorney Mark Anderson. Absent: Alderman Ken Bonine.

Attorney Mark Anderson gave an overview of progress in negotiations between the City of Earlville and the Teamsters saying that they are close to a Tentative Agreement. He stated the agreement at this point is a 2 - 2 - and 1.75 three year agreement and with a \$.05 increase in the longevity scale from the after 5 years if service step through after 25 years of service step and part-time officers to receive \$18.00 per hour for year one and two and \$18.50 for year three of the contract. He sought feedback and support from the council.

He also stated the police were seeking compensation for Alfonzo Valdez for assuming Chief responsibilities during the absence of a Chief.

Members supported Mr. Anderson.

At 7:53 p.m., Alderman Actis made a motion, seconded by Alderman Austin, to return to open session. On Roll Call: Alderman Actis - aye, Alderman Austin - aye, Alderman Jenkins - aye, Alderman Grimm - Aye, and Alderman Konsoer - aye. Alderman Jenkins by remote participation. Absent: Alderman Bonine. MOTION CARRIED.
